Terms and Conditions

Please read the following points carefully before booking.

1. These Terms & Conditions are specific to the Belper Strutts Society Christmas Fair and work alongside the Strutts Society Terms & Conditions, which will also be issued and require your agreement.
2. Your booking will only be accepted with payment in full and 6 weeks prior to 4th December 2010. Please make cheques payable to **Belper Strutts Society**. If you require an invoice, please confirm on the booking form.
3. The cost of the stall includes a table space (up to approximately 6 ft) and seating. If you require electricity, please state your requirement on the booking form (maximum 2 sockets available).
4. All tables must be covered to ground level.
5. Additional space for a rail or card table is subject to space being available on the day. Please indicate this on your booking form.
6. If you require extra space this must be negotiated by prior agreement and a charge may be incurred.
7. Shared access between exhibitors must be maintained.
8. You are NOT permitted to knock nails, etc, into the walls to hang your goods on.
9. Access to the venue is from 8.00 a.m. and we shall open to the public from 10.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. and you are required to man your stall until 5.00 p.m. as a courtesy to other traders.
10. To ensure a good balance of crafts, only a certain number of craftspeople in each type of craft will be taken and to be fair to everyone, you may only display your main craft and not diversify with anything else unless by prior agreement. We reserve the right to have the final say as to where your stall will be situation in the room.
11. Exhibitors must ensure that none of their display equipment extends beyond the space they have booked; this includes any rails, stands or additional equipment they may bring in addition to the table provided.
12. We, the organisers, cannot be help responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person at this Fair. It is your responsibility to insure your own stock and to ensure the area you occupy is kept tidy and hazard free.
13. Please ensure all your electrical equipment which you use at the Fair (including light and adapters, etc) has been P.A.T. tested. Neither the venue nor Belper Strutts Society can be held responsible for any accident concerning your appliances.
14. In the event of the cancellation, abandonment, limitation or postponement of the Fair including interruption or cessation of power supply, there will be no claim against the venue or Belper Strutts Society.
15. All exhibitors are responsible for arranging their own Public Liability Insurance and Employers Liability Insurance.
16. Exhibitors must remove all rubbish, wrapping and waste at the end of the Fair.
